In reference to Letter No-243/NI. MA. Dated- 03.06.2020, of the Director, Department of Education, Government of Bihar, we invited online survey from students, parents and teachers on 03/06/2020. The survey was based on the questionnaires that we received through this official order. The online survey was opened from 3rd June 2020 to 6th June 2020. We received 327 individuals opinion and the outcome of the survey are as follows:

- 1. About 86% favoured that school should be opened as early as possible may be between 20th June and 1st July. This statement was favoured by 86% of the total opinion that we received.
- 2. The process of new admission for the academic year 2020-21 to be effective yet again w.e.f from 10^{th} June 2020 till fulfil of requirement as per standard procedure.
- 3. No one favoured conduction of morning assembly till normalcy.
- 4. School timing should be as usual and should be between 7:00 am and 1:00pm.
- 5. Maximum Strength of students in each class should be 20 to 25. One student per bench and odd even formula should be implemented in attending the school by the students till normalcy.
- 6. Online classes should be taken into consideration as supplement till normalcy.
